NOTE: ANY DRIVEWAY WITH A PLUS GRADE OF 4% OR GREATER FROM TOWN ROAD MUST BE BLACKTOPPED ITS ENTIRE LENGTH AS ABOVE. INSTALL 15' WIDE X 10' DEEP ASPHALT APRON (3" MIN.) OVER 8" OF WELL COMPACTED R.O.B. GRAVEL

Conditions and Restrictions:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 149 of the Highway Law and Section 155-56 of the Town Code, in case the applicant shall fail to make any of the repairs required to be made under the permit, they may be made by the Town Superintendent at the expense of the applicant. The Town Superintendent may revoke such permit upon the applicant's failure to comply with any of the conditions contained therein.

This permit shall not be assigned or transferred without consent of the Town Superintendent of Highways.

This work authorized by this permit shall be performed under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Town Superintendent of Highways or his representative.

The Town Superintendent of Highways shall be given 48 hours notice by said applicant of the date when it intends to begin work authorized by this permit, and prompt notice of its completion.

The said applicant hereby agrees to hold the Town harmless on account of damages of any kind which may arise during the progress of the work authorized by this permit or by reason hereof.

Applicant certifies all persons concerned with actual work under this permit are duly covered by Workmen's Compensation Insurance and the Town shall be held harmless on account hereof.

The Town Superintendent of Highways reserves the right to, at any time, revoke or annul this permit should the said applicant fail to comply with the terms and conditions upon which it is granted.

Particular attention is called to the necessity of thoroughly compacting the bank fill, which will be required by the Town Superintendent; the top foot of which shall be good run of bank gravel.

It is agreed that the highway will be restored to its original condition where disturbed at the expense of the applicant as soon as the work has been completed.

The applicant, for himself, his distributees and personal representatives, covenants and agrees to defend any action or judgment recovered therein brought or found against the Town of Beekman of negligence arising out of any claim for damages or injuries to others, that the work and construction was defective, improperly protected or completed and to pay any judgment recovered on account of said claim.

The Town shall have the right to select counsel to represent it for the defense of any claim, suit or action arising hereunder, all fees and disbursements for the same to be paid by the applicant herein.

All work performed under this permit shall be in compliance with all relevant federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations including but not limited to Section 155-56 of the Town Code, Section H.

In consideration of granting this permit, the undersigned accepts it, subject to conditions described.
