- D. Koehler Confirms there is no new material to review and suggests applicant simply give an update.

Brian Hildenbrand - Project Engineer – Reference made to lot line change for Lots 2 and 3. The goal being to create area on lot 3 for a single-family house where trailer currently exists. Will create a zoning compliant building area down below closer to Frog Hollow. Have a submission into the health department for approval of septic. Taking through the process of planning board, health department and DEC. The second part of the project would be to create a farm access driveway to access the rear portion of lot 3 used for logging. This will require DEC permits for stream and wetland crossing. Submitted to DEC in April. Still under review.

D. Koehler – Confirms with applicant that there was no new submittal for review. States there were a number of comments from the May 16<sup>th</sup> letter that you can start taking care of as we had anticipated some of those to be done before the public hearing as part of the concept of pushing it.
