

**RE: AUTHORIZE RENEWAL OF INTER MUNICIPAL PROCUREMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF DUTCHESS AND THE TOWN OF BEEKMAN**

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.01(g) of the Dutchess County Administrative Code permits the County Executive, or his designee to “upon the request of any city, town, village, school district or other unit of local government, provide central purchasing services for all or part of its purchases, upon such conditions as may be prescribed by the County Legislature”, and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 2016290, the Dutchess County Legislature authorized the County Executive, or his designee, to enter into a shared services contract with any city, town, village, school district or other unit of local government who requested that the County assist it with certain central purchasing services, and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 2016290, the Dutchess County Legislature has prescribed conditions under which Dutchess County can provide central purchasing services to other units of local government, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Beekman has requested that the County of Dutchess assist with central purchasing services,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Beekman hereby authorizes the Supervisor to extend the Inter municipal Agreement with the County of Dutchess for the purpose of providing central purchasing services. This extension shall be effective from November 1, 2023 and shall terminated on October 31, 2024.

INTERMUNICIPAL  
AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, by and between the **COUNTY OF DUTCHESS**, a municipal corporation with offices at 22 Market Street, Poughkeepsie, New York 12601 (hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY") and the **TOWN OF BEEKMAN**, a municipal corporation, whose address is 4 Main Street, Poughquag, New York 12570 (hereinafter referred to as the "Municipality").

*WITNESSETH:*

WHEREAS, Section 3.01(g) of the Dutchess County Administrative Code permits the County Executive, or his designee, to "upon the request of any Municipality, town, village, school district or other unit of local government, provide central purchasing services for all or part of its purchases, upon such conditions as may be prescribed by the County Legislature", and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2016290, the Dutchess County Legislature authorized the County Executive, or his designee, to enter into a shared services contract with any Municipality, town, village, school district or other unit of local government who requested that the County assist it with certain central purchasing services, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2016290, the Dutchess County Legislature has prescribed conditions under which Dutchess County can provide central purchasing services to other units of local government, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has requested that the County of Dutchess assist it with central purchasing services, and

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law Section 119-o authorizes municipal corporations and districts to enter into agreements for the performance among themselves or one for the other of their respective functions, powers and duties on a contract basis, and

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law §119-n defines "municipal corporation" as a county outside the Municipality of New York, a town, a village, a board of cooperative educational services, fire district, or a school district, and defines a "municipal district" as a county or town improvement district, among other things, and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is intended to be used for municipal corporations and municipal districts who have requested assistance from the County with central purchasing services,

NOW, therefore, it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. SCOPE OF SERVICES. The County agrees to furnish the municipality with central purchasing services as set forth on the Scope of Services attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

2. TERM OF AGREEMENT. This Agreement shall be effective November 1, 2023 and shall terminate on October 31, 2024, unless otherwise terminated as set forth herein.

3. EXTENSION. This Agreement may be extended for additional periods of one year each, not exceeding in total five (5) years from the original Agreement date, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed between the parties in writing by fully executing a contract extension/amendment.

4. PAYMENT. As full and complete consideration for the services so rendered, the Municipality shall pay to the County SIXTY and 00/100 (\$60.00) DOLLARS per hour with a minimum of one (1) hour and thereafter, may be prorated in increments of fifteen (15) minutes, if applicable, per the Scope of Services attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

5. LIABILITY.

- (a) County: The County shall assume liability for, defend against, and secure the Municipality from all cost or damages for injury to persons or property, or death, caused by the negligent acts of any employees of the County. The County maintains general liability insurance and shall name the Municipality as additional insured on such policies for the services provided under this Agreement.
- (b) The Municipality shall assume liability for, defend against, and exempt the County from all costs or damages for injury to persons or property, or death, caused by the negligent acts of the Municipality, its employees, servants or agents arising out of the performance of this Agreement.

6. PERSONNEL.

- (a) Employee Status: For purposes of this Agreement only, all persons employed by the County in providing central purchasing services to the Municipality shall be County officers or employees, and they shall not have any benefit, status or right of Municipality employment.
- (b) Payment: The Municipality shall not be liable for the direct payments of salaries, wages or other compensation to County officers or employees providing central purchasing services to the Municipality under this Agreement.
- (c) All County employees performing services under this Agreement shall be deemed employees of the County for purposes of the Workers' Compensation Law and the Municipality shall not be responsible for the payment of any benefits thereunder.

7. NON-ASSIGNMENT. (a) This Agreement may not be assigned by the Municipality nor its right, title or interest therein assigned, transferred, conveyed, sublet or disposed of without the previous written consent of the County.

8. TERMINATION. (a) *Without cause*. The County may terminate this Agreement upon twenty (20) days prior written notice to the Municipality of its intent to terminate without cause.

(b) *With cause*. The County may terminate this Agreement effective immediately, with subsequent written notice to be given to the Municipality of termination with cause.

9. NON-WAIVER. Failure of either party to exercise any rights under this Agreement for a breach thereof shall not be deemed a waiver thereof or a waiver of any subsequent breach.

10. COOPERATION. In the event the Municipality is sued by a responder or bidder in connection with the award of a contract, the County agrees to make its employees involved in the procurement process available to participate in answering any inquiries, at no charge to the Municipality.

11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Agreement shall be held unenforceable, the rest of the Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.

12. CHOICE OF LAW, VENUE. Any dispute arising directly or indirectly out of this Agreement shall be determined pursuant to the laws of the State of New York. The parties hereby choose the New York State Supreme Court, Dutchess County as the forum for any such dispute.

13. NO ARBITRATION. Disputes involving this Agreement, including the breach or alleged breach thereof, may not be submitted to binding arbitration but must instead be heard in accordance with the Paragraph above entitled "Choice of Law, Venue".

14. RULES OF CONSTRUCTION. This Agreement shall be deemed to have been mutually prepared by the parties hereto and shall not be construed against any of them solely by reason of authorship.

15. COUNTERPARTS; SIGNATURES TRANSMITTED BY ELECTRONIC MEANS. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which taken together shall constitute one agreement, and any of the parties hereto may execute this Agreement by signing any such counterpart. A facsimile or signature transmitted by electronic means applied hereto or to any other document shall have the same force and effect as a manually signed original. This provision contemplates giving legal force and effect to copies of signatures. This provision does not contemplate the use of "electronic signatures" as regulated by New York State Technology Law Article 3, "Electronic Signatures and Records Act."


16. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. The terms of this Agreement, including its attachments and exhibits, represent the final intent of the parties. Any modification, rescission or waiver of the terms of this Agreement must be in writing and executed and acknowledged by the parties with the same formalities accorded this basic Agreement.





**ADDENDUM TO EXTEND SALT SHED AGREEMENT**

This ADDENDUM, dated as of November 8, 2023, by and between the COUNTY OF DUTCHESS (hereinafter referred to as the "County") a municipal corporation with offices at 22 Market Street, Poughkeepsie, New York 12601, and the TOWN OF BEEKMAN, a municipal corporation with offices at 4 Main Street, Poughquag, New York 12570 (hereinafter referred to as the "Town").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and the Town entered into an Agreement to share in the construction and usage of a sand/salt storage and distribution facility (the "Salt Shed"), commencing a fifteen (15) year term on August 26<sup>th</sup>, 1992, which Agreement was extended for an additional fifteen (15) year term, and which Agreement was extended for an additional six (6) month period, from September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the County and the Town wish to extend the term of this Agreement for a period that will afford the parties an appropriate opportunity to determine estimated costs for design and construction of recommended and agreed upon improvements to the Salt Shed, as well as time to negotiate a new agreement which contemplates a cost sharing model for proposed and future improvements required at the Salt Shed; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Town mutually recognize the need for the continued joint operation of the existing Salt Shed during the above referenced negotiations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto confirm and agree as follows:

**LEASE EXTENSION:** The County and the Town hereby agree to extend the Agreement for a period of five (5) months, commencing on November 8, 2023 and ending on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** All terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement and any amendments thereof are hereby incorporated by reference and shall continue in effect during this extended term as if set forth herein.

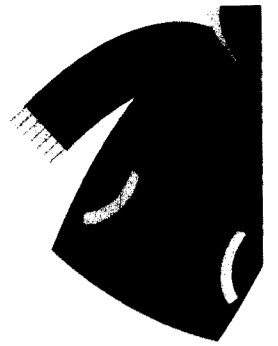
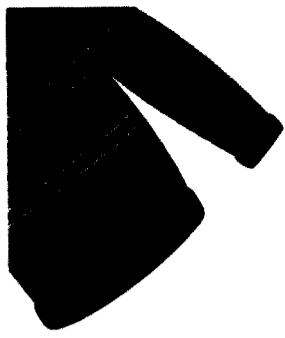
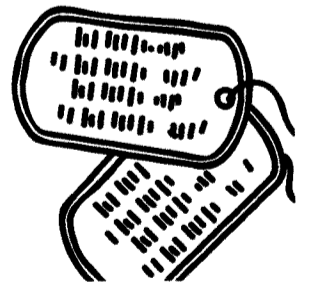

Re: DEC policy on logging & protected species

Dear Ms. Masi:

We are residents of Gardner Hollow Road in Poughquag, NY, who have been deeply concerned about the logging of over 200 acres of beautiful forest at the top of our road. The logging took place this winter and spring on property owned by Starkdale Farm in Dover (623 W. Dover Rd.), adjacent to the West Mountain State Forest.

The forest, in its totality, is cherished by many residents in our region. It provides habitats to a variety of wildlife, including three state or federally protected species: the Indiana bat, the bog turtle, and the New England cotton tail rabbit.


When discussing the matter with DEC staff, we learned that logging is permitted so long as it occurs while endangered or threatened species are dormant. But what happens to the animals when they awaken in the spring? They will find that their homes are gone! This is not protection.

We urge the DEC to change its policy and to forbid all logging, at any time of the year, in forests in which protected species reside.
