Supervisor Covucci led the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Covucci pointed out the emergency exits and called for a moment of silence for all those who have served our Country.

Supervisor Covucci went over the agenda items

Public Comments on the agenda: Jayson Abbatantuono 20 Gabriels Path, Resolution # 10 "Approve Auditor For Auditing of 2024" expressed his concerns on repeated unreasonable actions of individuals or groups directed at an employee or a group of employees which is intended to intimidate. This creates a risk to the health and safety of the employees; workplace bullying often involves abuse of misuse of power. He addressed the Town Supervisor, Town Attorney and Town Board on the Resolution and the \$4500.00 per department that is being spent on an Audit for the Town Clerk/Tax Receivers office and does hope that it highlights the need for additional help in those departments to improve process. Bill Crane, 254 Gardener Hollow Road, Resolution #11, "Climate Smart Community" I just want to give my thanks and congratulations on putting this on the agenda. The "Climate Smart Community" can stimulate all kinds of exciting projects, new projects from recycling, to tree planting and tree preservation. It will put us in a position to be much more competitive with respect to grants and will be a great savings to the town. It's a really great and I am glad that Suzette has come forward and volunteered to be the interim chair of the CAC.

Town Board members read the Resolutions;

Public Comments: Bill Crane, 254 Gardener Hollow Road, acknowledged the passing of Pope Francis the Patron Saint of the animals and the environment. Bill said Earth Day, it makes him feel good to think about how much the earth gives us, the water we drink and all the plants, the food we eat and the air we breathe. Also he hopes that when it comes to cutting down trees that more people will think about how they absorb the carbon dioxide and assist in global warming. Kate Blake 231 Clap Hill Road, at the last meeting the Town Board discussed re-upping the contract with logically for IT services and she had noted that it was going to be a pretty significant increase in monthly costs, she apologized that she didn't have the figures right now but she thinks it was somewhere between \$1,000 and \$1,500 a month. When I brought it up it was mentioned that it was a shared service. She just wanted to request that going forward maybe the Town Board could do a discussion on the topic so that the community can learn more about it.

General Board Comments: Town Attorney, Craig Wallace made a comment regarding statements or comments regarding certain types of investigations and should not be discussed by any audience member. **Town Clerk Laureen Abbatantuono** shared her experience while attending Honor Flight #35. It is a day that she will never forget, what an Honor it was to be chosen to chaperone a Combat Medic from the Vietnam War. Also, presented dates for the 2025 Property Taxes as well as a brief statement regarding the collection. She thanked Bill Crane for hosting his event at the Safe Haven Farm, it was a great day.
